



BODEGAS

AVGVSTA BILBILIS

Variety: 100% Grenache from our own vineyards

ABV: 14.5%

Ageing: Eight months in new French oak barrels

Tasting notes: Raspberry-red. Fine and intense on the nose. The aromas are redolent of the terroir with crisp notes of woodland, pine and fir. Balsamic notes make their presence known with, touches of eucalyptus, rosemary and bay leaf. Very pleasant freshly baked bread and dairy aromas.

Well balanced and structured in the mouthfeel, with fine grained tannins, somewhat sharp but well-rounded and fully integrated, with a long and extremely elegant finish.

Retronasal aromas of menthol, celery, verbena and new wood. The dairy notes of blackberry, blackcurrant and raspberry yogurt emerge again.

Best served at: 14-16°C

Pairs with: Wonderful with red meats, carpaccios, game, confits, aromatic stews.
